## SYSTEMATIC SEARCHING

✓ Literature search training (or we can search for you)

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- ✓ Develop draft Medline strategy (~2 weeks)
- Read: 'Understanding a systematic review strategy'
- Feedback and liaison to confirm the final version of the search strategy (time dependent on reviewer)
- ✓ Translate across agreed databases for "full run"

## WRITE UP - summarise your findings

- ✓ Re-run searches
- ✓ Write methods section
- ✓ Review manuscript
- ✓ Check against PRISMA criteria
- ✓ Advise on publishing
